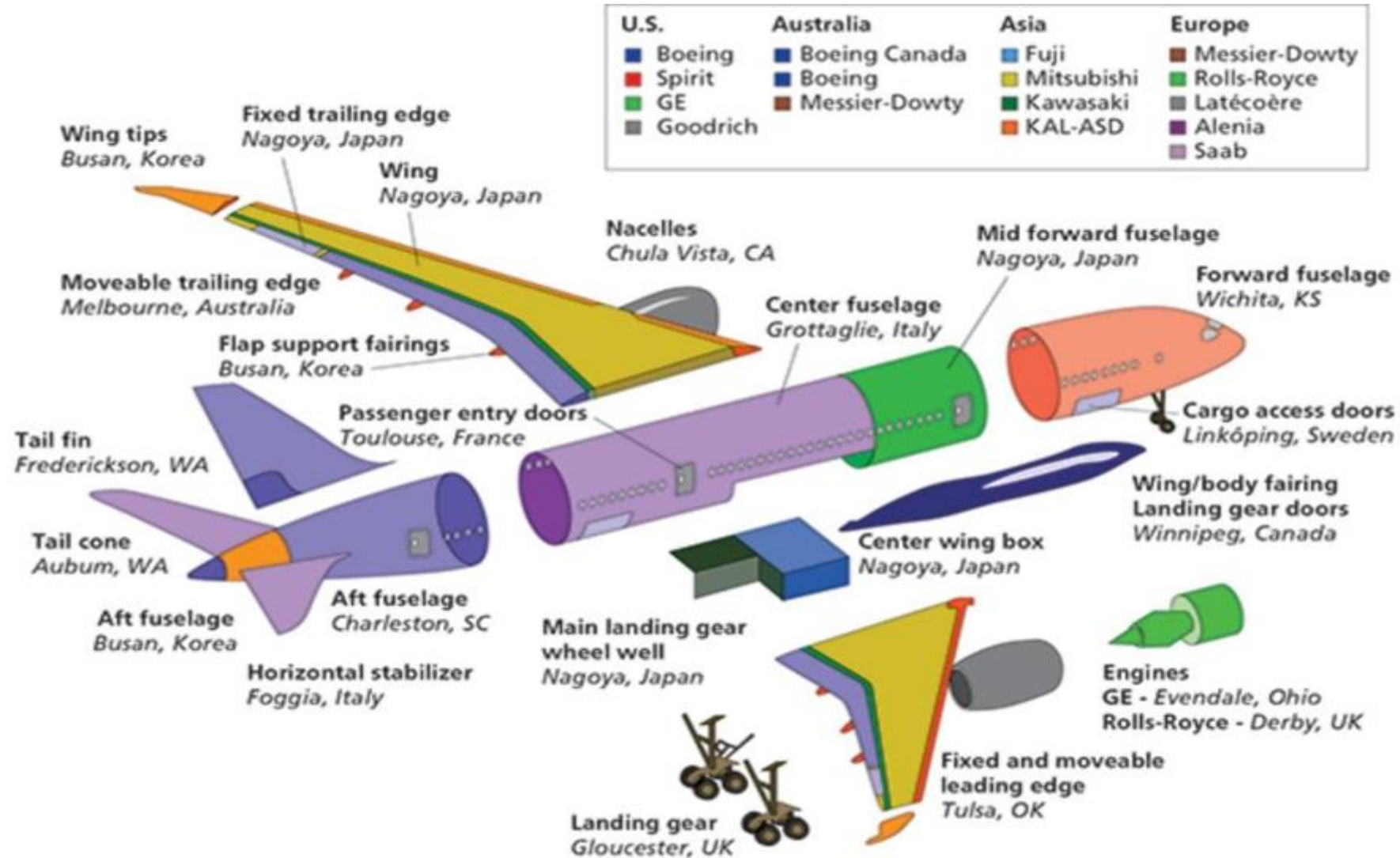

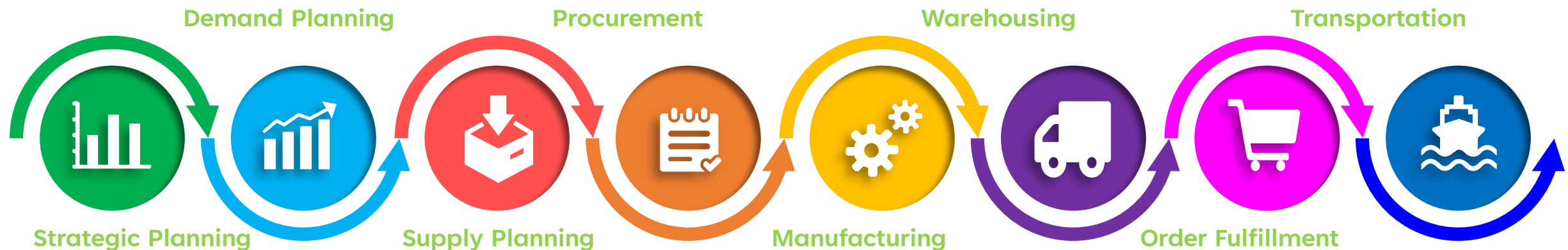

- 5 Potential supply chain risks and weaknesses.





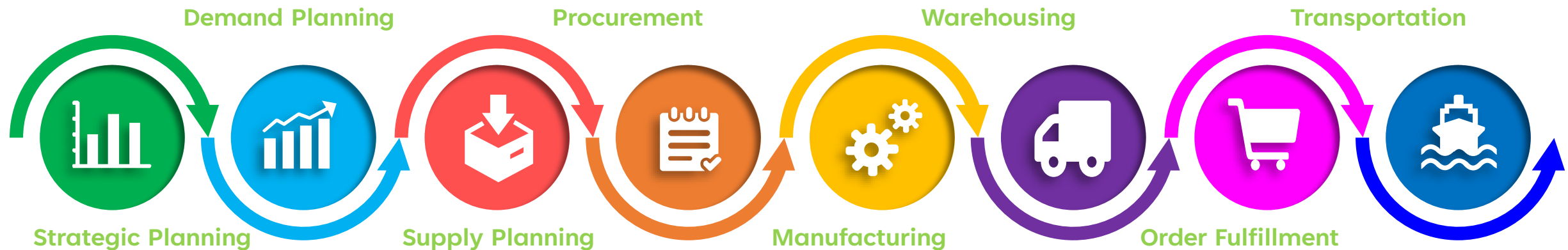

Dynamic

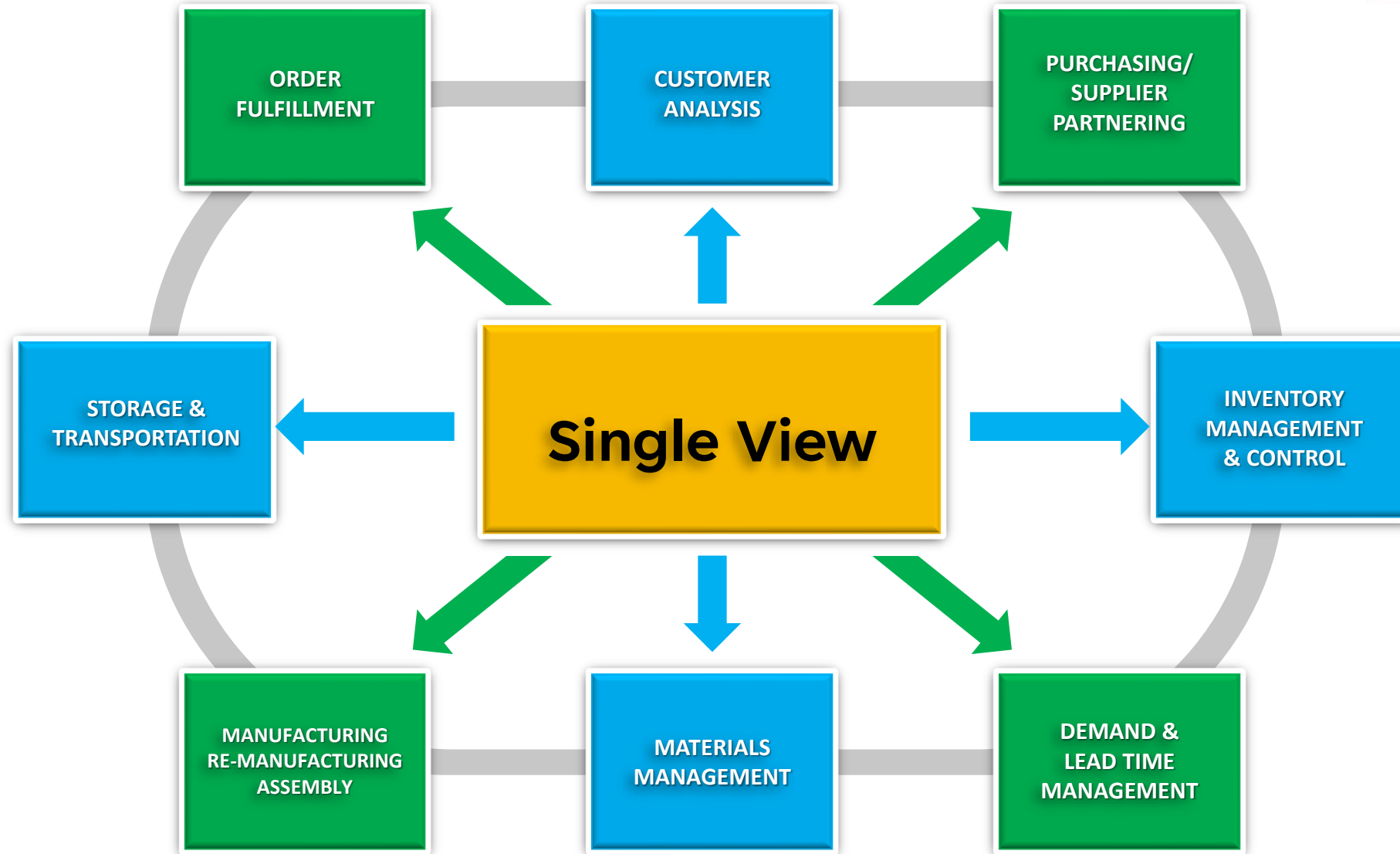
Monitor and respond to events in real time

- 5 Returns collected and processed on time ?



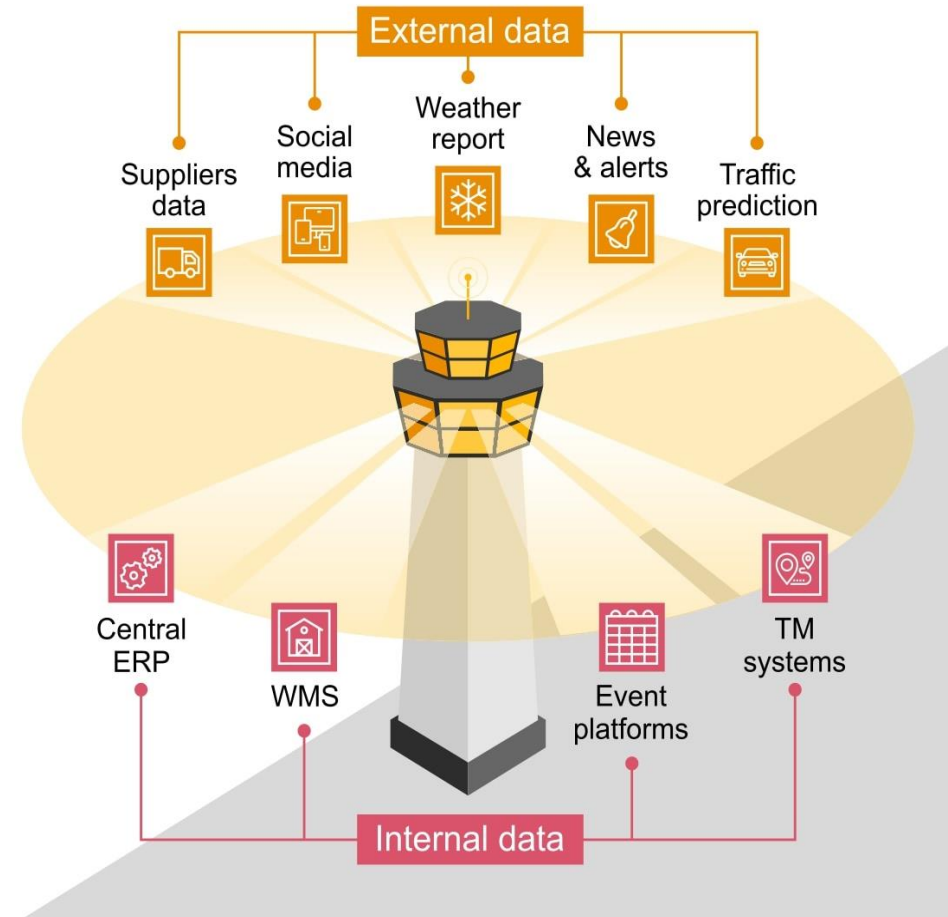
